For many years, the County Store has recognized the value of our youth and the need to help foster the “learn by doing” philosophy embraced by organizations like 4-H, FFA, Grange and Pony Clubs. We believe that it is through these programs that our youth gain a greater understanding of the world around them as it relates to citizenship, healthy living and an appreciation for our agricultural roots. We also acknowledge that supplies that aid in this learning can often be costly. The Country Store’s Youth Rewards Program was developed to help ease some of these expenses for the youth participants.

Program details:

- Purchases must be made on Youth Rewards Program account to be eligible for discounts and/or rebates.
- A new Youth Rewards Program application must be completed and submitted each program year to be eligible for discounts and program rebates. The program runs Oct. 1 through Sept. 30 each year.
- Students from ages 5 to 18 years old, or until high school graduation year, are eligible for the Youth Rewards Program benefits.
- At the end of the program year, clubs will receive a rebate check for 5% of Country Store purchases of participating Youth Rewards Members. The more your club’s members spend at the Country Store, the more your club gets back - fundraising made easy! (\$500 max rebate amount.)
